Children's Memorial Hermann Hospital

Located within Memorial Hermann-TMC, Children's Memorial Hermann Hospital is a 332-bed women's and children's comprehensive, complex care hospital that includes a 118-bed Level IV neonatal intensive care unit (NICU)—the highest level of care available for premature and critically ill newborns—and the region's busiest Level I pediatric trauma center. The hospital's unique position, located within a comprehensive adult care facility, allows for care of the entire family under the same roof.

As the primary teaching hospital for the pediatric and obstetric/gynecologic programs for McGovern Medical School at UTHealth Houston, Children's Memorial Hermann Hospital offers care in more than 40 children's and women's specialties. This includes the latest advances in high-risk pregnancy and neonatal critical care

In addition, physicians affiliated with the hospital are national leaders in the diagnosis and treatment of abnormalities in unborn and newborn infants, including fetal intervention and fetal surgery. Through a comprehensive approach to multidisciplinary, individualized care for each patient, Children's Memorial Hermann Hospital provides services for children and women in all stages of life.

Cancer Center

The Memorial Hermann Cancer Center is built on years of experience and extensive knowledge in helping thousands of cancer patients in Houston find hope and healing. Treatment teams at the Center put patients first and support them with affiliated physician expertise, advanced treatments and supportive caregivers. They offer a full array of multidisciplinary services, including surgery, chemotherapy, radiation therapy, nutritional counseling, laboratory services and pain management. A team of nationally recognized affiliated oncologists and researchers offers access to the latest procedures and clinical trials, working together to develop new and successful treatments to improve cancer survival rates and quality of life. They are proud to be leaders in providing personalized, research-driven, evidence-based care to patients in a comforting environment.

In an effort to keep the community informed with accurate and relevant information about cancers in our specialty areas, the Cancer Center provides education and support groups offered both in person and virtually for patients and caregivers to gain knowledge and insight on a variety of cancers, what to expect during cancer treatment, patient stories and more.

Ertan Digestive Disease Center

The Ertan Digestive Disease Center provides comprehensive medical and surgical treatment for patients with diseases of the esophagus, stomach, intestine, pancreas, biliary tract and liver. Physicians affiliated with the Center treat a broad range of conditions and patients have access to various advanced GI endoscopic therapeutic modalities in a tertiary care setting. In collaboration with the Ertan Digestive Disease Center, the Texas Liver Center is an outpatient center managed by Memorial Hermann-TMC, providing high-quality, effective care for patients with chronic and acute liver disease. The Ertan Digestive Disease Center and Texas Liver Center integrate surgical expertise into the management of chronic liver disease, chronic pancreatitis, portal hypertension and benign and malignant tumors of the liver, pancreas and biliary tree.

John S. Dunn Burn Center

The John S. Dunn Burn Center is a collaborative effort between Memorial Hermann-TMC and the division of Acute Care Surgery at McGovern Medical School at UTHealth Houston. It is the only comprehensive burn center in Houston and is verified by the American Burn Association. The affiliated board-certified physicians at the burn center care for all types of burn

injuries, inhalation injuries and various skin disorders, including Stevens-Johnson syndrome and toxic epidermal necrolysis. The burn team provides the entire continuum of care, including critical care, acute inpatient care, burn reconstruction and scar management and rehabilitation.

Heart & Vascular Institute

Memorial Hermann is at the forefront of advancing heart health, from preventive care to cardiac emergencies to complex surgical procedures. The Heart & Vascular Institute at Memorial Hermann-TMC is home to a number of specialties and offers the most complex care for all heart and vascular patients, combining research-driven innovation and a heart team approach.

Researchers and clinicians bring groundbreaking discoveries from the laboratory to the bedside, making the Institute one of the world's leading cardiovascular hospitals. Backed by a commitment to excellence in care and research, the Institute's role as the primary teaching facility for the cardiology, cardiothoracic and vascular surgery programs at McGovern Medical School at UTHealth Houston, ensures patients have access to cutting-edge programs and technology.

With state-of-the-art cardiac catheterization labs, hybrid operating-endovascular suites, a cardiovascular intensive care unit (CV-ICU) and dedicated cardiac rehabilitation, the board-certified diagnostic, interventional and electrophysiology cardiologists, as well as cardiovascular and thoracic surgeons affiliated with our program work with a dedicated staff of caregivers to offer a spectrum of heart-related treatment options, including:

- Advanced cardiology, imaging and interventional cardiology
- Advanced heart failure, heart transplant, lung transplant and advanced structural heart research studies
- Access to advanced technology with remote monitoring capabilities
- Minimally invasive procedures, including transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR), left atrial appendage occlusion (LAAO) therapy for AFib, transcatheter edge-to-edge repair (TEER) of the mitral valve for mitral regurgitation, coronary bypass graft surgery (CABG) and video assisted thorascopic surgery (VATS) and more
- Specialized aortic surgery, endovascular and traditional surgical options (angioplasty, stents, aortic aneurysms, deep vein thrombosis, peripheral arterial disease and more)
- Cardiac (open heart) and thoracic surgery
- Cardiac and vascular rehabilitation
- Heart disease risk assessment
- Lifestyle and medical management
- Diagnostic testing, including advanced and non-invasive imaging, advanced cardiac electrophysiology (arrhythmia), lead extraction and peripheral invasive radiology

The Heart & Vascular Institute at Memorial Hermann-TMC is Chest Pain certified by The Joint Commission and meets stringent criteria for rapid response when seconds count.

Memorial Hermann | Rockets Orthopedic Hospital

The Memorial Hermann | Rockets Orthopedic Hospital is a dedicated facility for elective orthopedic and spine surgery under the management of Memorial Hermann-TMC. The dedicated multidisciplinary orthopedic care team and Joint Center includes specialty-trained, affiliated physicians, nurses and rehabilitation specialists who provide non-surgical and minimally invasive procedures, surgery and rehabilitation for muscle, joint and bone injuries and abnormalities. As part of patient-centered care, therapists perform comprehensive evaluations to determine appropriate treatment to individually address each patient's goals.

Joint Center

The Joint Center at Memorial Hermann | Rockets Orthopedic Hospital has a team dedicated to joint replacement surgery. The Joint Center has been recognized twice with The Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval® for knee replacement and hip replacement surgery. Most knee replacements are performed using a special technique that gets patients back on their feet quicker. Quad-sparing total knee replacement is a minimally invasive surgery done through a small incision.

The Joint Center offers a full range of non-surgical and surgical options, including:

- Medications
- Injections
- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Knee replacement
- Knee replacement revisions
- Hip replacement including the anterior approach to hip replacement

Memorial Hermann | Rockets Sports Medicine Institute

With affiliated specialists in spine, shoulder, elbow, hip, knee, foot and ankle conditions and total joint replacement, Memorial Hermann-TMC's sports medicine and orthopedics program is one of the most comprehensive in the region. The cornerstone of the program is the Memorial Hermann | Rockets Sports Medicine Institute, where physicians and staff help athletes at all levels—recreational, competitive or professional—stay in the game and achieve a higher level of performance.

Mischer Neuroscience Institute

Mischer Neuroscience Institute at Memorial Hermann-TMC brings together an affiliated team of nationally and internationally recognized clinicians, researchers and educators whose insights and research findings are transforming the field of neuroscience. Patients come to the Institute from around the world, seeking treatment for both rare and common diseases of the brain and spine.

As a Comprehensive Stroke Center accredited by both The Joint Commission and the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association, the Institute is a national leader in stroke treatment. It also offers the largest and most comprehensive neuroscience program in Texas, including centers of excellence for the treatment of brain tumors, cerebrovascular disease, pediatric neurological disorders, epilepsy, movement disorders and neurodegenerative diseases, neurocognitive disorders, multiple sclerosis, neuromuscular diseases, spine, neuro-trauma/critical care and neurorehabilitation.

More than 5,000 patients are surgically treated annually, including more than 400 brain tumor operations, more than 250 functional neurosurgical procedures and over a thousand spinal operations along with a large number of elective procedures.

Red Duke Trauma Institute

As one of the busiest Level I trauma centers in the nation the Red Duke Trauma Institute at Memorial Hermann-TMC brings together a superior team of clinicians, researchers and educators to treat the most complex adult and pediatric trauma cases. The Institute is also home to Memorial Hermann/Life Flight®, a hospital-based air ambulance service that flies more than 3,500 missions each year. Accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Medical Transport Systems, Life Flight operates helicopters within a 150-mile radius of the Texas Medical Center and uses airplane transport worldwide.

Sleep Disorders Center

Specialists at the Memorial Hermann Sleep Disorders Center provide comprehensive care with an emphasis on assessing abnormal sleep and the effects of abnormal sleep on other medical disorders.

The lab features advanced computer technology and rooms designed to resemble a comfortable bedroom in a home or hotel. Under the supervision of board-certified and affiliated physicians specializing in sleep disorders, a polysomnographic technologist provides round-the-clock supervision and monitoring. Our skilled staff serves patients of any age, including those with the most difficult medical conditions.

Specialty Surgery Services

Memorial Hermann-TMC offers a complete range of surgical services, including ambulatory and minimally invasive surgery, whose affiliated physicians utilize procedures associated with less pain and scarring and faster recovery. The comprehensive programs include bariatrics; ear, nose and throat; urology; gynecology; general surgery; ophthalmology; and plastic surgery.

NewStart™ Surgical Weight Loss Program

Transplant Center



Women's Memorial Hermann

Wound Care

Located on campus, the Wound Care program provides a comprehensive approach to treating patients with chronic non-healing wounds. Patients have access to the most efficient and effective treatment options available today. The experienced team features affiliated physicians, nurses and technicians with advanced training in wound care and hyperbaric oxygen therapy (HBOT). We provide interdisciplinary, comprehensive wound management that integrates advanced wound care techniques, products and services. Patients receive evaluation for possible physical conditions, such as diabetes, that could interfere with proper healing. The care team follows evidence-based clinical pathways to determine why wounds may not be healing. Individual treatment plans feature the most effective technologies available to optimize healing and provide relief for patients.
